



Fraser Skies Area Adult Leadership Award Guidelines

Girl Guides of Canada Fraser Skies Area values its members and wishes to promote their personal development and empower them to be responsible citizens. To meet this goal Fraser Skies Area will offer two (2) Leadership Awards valued at \$500 each to an adult member who best fulfills the requirements set out in these guidelines. The Leadership Award will be presented for financial assistance towards formal education in a field that will enhance the life of the recipient. GUIDELINES

1. The applicant must be a current member of Girl Guides in Fraser Skies Area and have been a registered member for at least 3 years. To be awarded to a well-rounded active member of Girl Guides of Canada - Guides du Canada, age 25 and over, residing in British Columbia. The applicant may not be a previous recipient of a Fraser Skies (formerly Delrey, Peace Arch or Cheam) Area Scholarship.
2. The applicant must be planning to attend a recognized post-secondary institution or education program (university, college, vocational institute or other recognized institute). The Leadership Award is conditional upon acceptance at the institution of the applicant's choice and will only be awarded when proof of registration has been received in the form of a receipt for fees or a letter from the institution indicating registration is complete (copy is fine).
3. The applicant must plan to continue volunteering for Girl Guides in the Fraser Skies Area for a further two years.
4. The award must be used within 18 months of the presentation date.
5. Candidate will be evaluated in eight categories:
 - Guiding History (iMIS record)
 - Employment Positions Held
 - Community Service/Volunteer Involvement/Job skills
 - Additional Interests and Activities
 - Applicant's descriptive account of "How Guiding has Inspired Me"
 - Confidential Reference Letter (outside Guiding)
 - Confidential Reference Letter (inside Guiding)
 - Plans for the future

Applications must be received by April 1st no exceptions.
